MINUTES MONTHLY ORONOCO TOWN BOARD MEETING APRIL 4, 2016

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The monthly Oronoco Town Board Meeting was called to order on April 4, 2016 at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Thein. Supervisors Neil Stolp, Richard Lyke and treasurer, Kim Stanton were present.

Neil Stolp made a motion to approve the March 14, 2016 minutes, Richard Lyke seconded. Motion carried.

The order of agenda was set changed by putting Metes and Bounds #OR2016-001MB before The Old Business.

The Treasurer's report in written form showed the year to date "Statement of Receipts, Disbursements and Balances" as of March 31, 2016: Receipts \$36,765.67 and Disbursements \$153,770.62 with an ending balance of \$316,582.91. After discussion, the board decided that the CD 1 for \$101,541.71 should not be renewed in May. Those funds should be made available in the event they are needed before the second half Olmsted County distribution is made. The check to the Pine Island Area Fire District for \$61,802.00 was voided – waiting for a corrected invoice. Richard Lyke made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Neil Stolp seconded, motion carried.

Richard Lyke reported that the OPAC meeting was held March 21. The business at hand was Oronoco Township #OR2015-001ZC, zoning district amendment to rezone outlots to allow flexibility in redevelopment of the lots in Cedar Beach. Because of the concerns and questions brought forth by Cedar Beach residents, any action on #OR2015-001ZC is being continued.

First Responders reported six runs, three township and three city.

The bills were presented for payment, a total \$11,261.07. Neil Stolp made a motion to approve the April bills. Mark Thein seconded, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Metes and Bounds Subdivision #OR2016-001MB: Applicant, Joan Ries, request to divide a 76 acre parcel into three parcels, one farm parcel, one parcel to be combined with the neighbor's property, and one non-farm or farmstead parcel containing a dwelling. The property owner is Jean Bigelow, location; 8017 60th Ave NW, Section 31, Oronoco Township.

After discussion, Mark Thein made a motion to approve Metes and Bounds Subdivision #OR2016-001MB. Neil Stolp seconded, motion carried.

Oronoco Township #OR2015-00ZC: re-tabled until the May meeting.

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John Meyer from Rockdell Township presented the Board with proposed legislation regarding the zip rail. The primary concerns for legislation would be to prohibit the use of public funding, no eminent domain and a corridor analysis of purpose and need comparing now and the future. After considerable discussion, Mark Thein made a motion to approve "Resolution of Support for HF920" and "Resolution of Support for HF3659" officially supporting and encourage adoption of Minnesota Bill H.F.3659 and H.F. 920 by the Minnesota State Legislature. Richard Lyke seconded, motion carried 3-0.

Bids:

Bids were submitted by: Roberson Lime & Rock, Inc, Milestone Materials, Bruening Rock Products, Inc, Ron Haglund, and Schumacher Excavating. Neil Stolp made a motion to accept all bids, Mark Thein seconded. Motion carried 3-0. Mark Thein made a motion to make Roberson Lime & Rock the primary winter and summer provider with Milestone the secondary provider. Schumacher Excavating and Ron Haglund will continue with road maintenance. Neil Stolp seconded, motion carried 3-0.

- Neil Stolp made a motion to approve Oronoco Township Resolution Approving Plans and Specifications and Calling for Advertisement for Bids, Cedar Beach Community Wastewater collection and Treatment System. Richard Lyke seconded, motion carried.

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- Mark Thein made a motion to approve the Variance Request Application from the Minnesota Department of Health, Well Management Section regarding the type of pipe to use for the Cedar Beach Project. Neil Stolp seconded, motion carried 3-0. A check for \$235.00 will be sent along with the application.
- Sheila inquired as to a work in right of way permit. This would not be required.
- Select a bond counsel. Kennedy & Graven was used for Kings Park project, however, Sheila will be asking for quotes.
- Select a service provider; Gopher is the provider for Kings Park project, however, Shelia will be asking for quotes.
- Mark Thein made a motion to issue a check to Joseph Guzinski for \$33,000.00, the purchase agreement price (\$33,500.00 \$500.00 earnest money= \$33,000.00). Richard Lyke seconded, motion carried 3-0.
